Charge Lunch Policy: The following procedures will be followed in the school cafeteria:

First charged meal: Students will be served the meal of their choice second & third charged meal: Students will be served a peanut butter and jelly or ham and cheese sandwich, fruit, vegetable and milk. If the charges have not been paid after the third charge, students will be sent to the building Principal and a letter will be mailed to the parents/guardians, followed by a phone call from the Principal's office.

Cellphone Policy: Just a reminder that cell phones should be put away upon entering the classroom. At no time should phone calls be made as well as photos or videos be taken. When listening to music in the cafeteria or during transition times please utilize one earbud only for safety purposes. Finally there should be no texting snapchat or other social media to harass, intimidate or bully any other student. PSAT: The PSAT is being given at MSHS on Saturday, October 15th. The fee to take the test is \$20 and the PSAT is the official practice test for the SAT. Sophomores and juniors who are planning to go directly to a 4 year college after high school are encouraged to take the test. For juniors who intend to go to a 4 year college, this is a very important test because it only happens once each year. Reminder to all students attending Friday night's football game: The following rules will be in effect for fans attending our home football games:

- All students in 8th grade and below MUST be accompanied by a parent or guardian at the football game. Please remember that students are not to congregate and loiter during and after the game. Security and police have been instructed to have people move to the bleachers. Students who are disruptive in any way, including running, will be removed from the game and are subject to school discipline as this is a school sponsored event. Bags, food, and drinks are prohibited from being brought into the stadium. Also, state law prohibits smoking on all school grounds (this includes all athletic fields at the Senior High School and Memorial High School).

At the end of the third quarter the gates will be locked and no one will be permitted to enter the game.
