## The Curriculum

Millville Senior High School offers students a comprehensive curriculum including 13 Advanced Placement courses as well as Honors and College Preparatory levels in all major subject areas. Our grading scale is A+ = 100 – 98; A = 97 – 95; A- = 94 – 92; B+ = 91 – 89; B = 88 – 86; B- = 85 – 83; C+ = 82 – 80; C = 79 – 77; C- = 76 – 74; D+ = 73 – 71; D = 70 – 68; D- = 67 – 65; F = 64 - 0.

Graduation requirements include 4 years of English, Physical Education and Health; 3 years of Mathematics and Science; 2 years of United States History; 1 year each of World Language, World History, Fine Art, and Practical Art. The total graduation credit requirement is 125 credits.

### Rank in Class

Final class rank is determined at the end of the third marking period of the senior year. Additional weight is given for upper level college preparatory and advanced courses. #### Full – (A+ = 5.25)

Thirteen Advanced Placement subjects are offered including United States History, World History, Biology, Calculus 1, Calculus 2, Chemistry, English, Physics, Psychology, Macro-Economics, Music Theory, Studio Art, and Computer Science  
Also full weighted – Latin 4, Spanish 4, German 4, French 4, Latin 5, Spanish 5, German 5, French 5

#### Half – (A+ = 4.75)

The following courses are half weighted: Adv. Algebra, Adv. U.S. History, Adv. Biology, Adv. English, Adv. World History, Alg 3/Trig, Bio 2, Adv. Chemistry, French 3, German 3, Latin 3, Adv. Physics, Precalculus, Spanish 3, Statistics, Accounting 3 and Music Theory 1.  
All other courses are non-weighted (A+ = 4.25).
