



AHERA ANNUAL NOTIFICATION

Review of work performed during the 2013-2014 school year.

Dear Parents, Students, Employees:

In 1986, Congress passed the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). This required schools to be inspected to identify any asbestos containing building materials. All Millville School buildings were inspected and suspected materials were sampled to be tested and rated according to condition and potential hazard. Every three years, Millville Schools are required to be re-inspected to determine if any known or suspected asbestos containing building materials (ACBM) has changed and to make recommendations on managing or removing the ACBM.

The law further requires an asbestos management plan be developed to monitor any known or suspected ACBM. The plan has several ongoing requirements including: This notification letter announcing the availability of the management plans for anyone to review upon request, training of the support staff about asbestos and how to deal with it, notifying short term workers such as sub-contractors of the locations of any known or suspected ACBM and posting of warning signs adjacent to locations of known or suspected ACBM. The designated asbestos coordinator conducts a six-month inspection of areas of the buildings where known or suspected ACBM are located to assure they remain in good condition.

It is the intention of Millville Schools to comply with all federal and state regulations controlling asbestos and to take whatever steps are necessary to ensure students and employees a healthy and safe environment in which to learn and work.

A copy of each school's asbestos management plan is available in the school's main office and you are welcome to review a copy of the asbestos management plan upon request.

July 16, 2013, Rieck Avenue E.S. – Sampling of floor tile prior to maintenance activities – results positive for asbestos.

July 18, 2013, RM Bacon E.S. – Sampling of floor tile prior to maintenance activities – results positive for asbestos

August 8, 2014, Senior H.S. – Sampling of pipe insulation prior to maintenance activities – results negative for asbestos.

August 8 – 10, 2014

RM Bacon E.S. – Removal of asbestos floor tile in PE Office prior to maintenance activities.

Rieck Avenue E.S. – removal of asbestos floor tile in D204, D205, D231, A208, B107, B-hall custodial closet.

November, 20, 2013 Mount Pleasant E.S. – Sampling of roof deck prior to summer roof replacement project – results positive for asbestos.

February 26, 2014, Mount Pleasant E.S. – Sampling roofing materials prior to summer roof replacement project – results negative for asbestos

February 26, 2014, Memorial H.S. – Sampling roofing materials prior to summer roof replacement project – results inconclusive

March 8, 2014, Memorial H.S. – Re-sampling roofing material prior to summer roof replacement project – results negative for asbestos

April 7, 2014, Memorial H.S. – Inspection of possible asbestos panels prior to summer roof replacement project – results positive for asbestos.
