

Unfortunately, students who do perform well on every day tasks are not always recognized. There is now an option to recognize the success of students who stay away from negative influences, attend school regularly, are involved in positive activities, and perform well in school. That option is Renaissance. Founded by educators in 1988, Renaissance is a nationally based organization that recognizes daily student achievement. Our goal for Millville High School students is to also recognize those students who are currently performing at high levels and to maintain a positive school climate which will benefit our community for future generations.

How does it work?

Renaissance is based on four criteria: Academic standing, Attendance, Discipline, and involvement in a positive student activity. Students who exhibit exemplary behavior, perform well in their respective courses, regularly attend school and are involved in positive activities will be invited to join the Renaissance program. By joining the Renaissance program students will earn rewards based on their merit.

What’s the next step?

If you are invited to participate in the Renaissance program you will receive a Renaissance Card and a letter explaining all of the benefits that Renaissance has to offer. If you are not initially invited to join Renaissance, you will have the opportunity to participate if you satisfy all of the requirements on a semester basis. This way, you will receive all of the benefits that Renaissance has to offer. On the following page is the criteria needed to participate in the Renaissance Card Program.

Millville High School: Renaissance Card Requirements

Gold Card

- An overall GPA that demonstrates a G.P.A. of 3.5 average or higher
- No discipline referrals
- MSHS Criteria for perfect attendance (lates/absences)
- Involved in either a co-curricular activity or employment after school

Orange Card

- An overall GPA that exhibits a 3.0 – 3.49 average
- Only 4.5 unexcused absences/lates per semester
- No discipline referrals
- Involved in either a co-curricular activity or employment after school

Blue Card

- An overall GPA that exhibits a 2.5 – 3.0 average
- Only 4.5 unexcused absences/lates per semester
- No internal or external suspensions
- Involved in either a co-curricular activity or employment after school
