BUSING INFORMATION

The Millville Board of Education announces that bus passes are being processed and will be mailed to those students who are eligible for transportation. The school board policy for transportation is as follows:

Beyond 1 ½ miles for kindergarten through 8th grade
Beyond 2 miles for 9th grade through 12th grade

Bus passes will include student's name and address, grade, school of attendance, route number and location of stop. Bus route numbers will be posted in the front window of the bus. Students should be at their bus stop 15 minutes prior to the bus pickup time designated on the bus pass. All preschool children are eligible for bus service; preschool children must have an adult meet them at the bus stop. Please call 293-2051 or 293-2052 if you have any questions or concerns.

All Millville School District students are required to wear seat belts while being transported to and from school, on field trips, sports activities and all other Millville School District sponsored activities. Parents are asked to review the bus rules that will be sent home with students. All rules will also be posted on the district website, mps.millvillenj.gov. Remember that riding the bus is a privilege. All children will have a safe ride by respecting their driver and obeying the rules.

CAFETERIA

The school cafeterias will be open for the first day of classes. Paid lunch prices are \$2.90 for elementary schools and Child Family Center and \$3.00 for Lakeside Middle, Memorial and Senior High Schools. The school breakfast program will be available at all schools for \$1.85.

SCHOOL AGE CHILD CARE (Latchkey)

WRAP AROUND (CHILD FAMILY CENTER)

Wrap Around child care is available for all Child Family Center children from 7:00 am to 8:00 am and 2:00 pm to 5:30 pm. It is free for all eligible families.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

In compliance with NJ State Law, preschool students must show proof of the pneumococcal conjugate vaccine series and an annual influenza vaccine in addition to all of the usual childhood immunizations required for admittance to public schools. All entrants into kindergarten must have a DTAP on or after their fourth birthday, or any five doses, a polio booster on or after the fourth birthday or any four doses and a second measles, mumps and rubella vaccine given after the first birthday. A minimum of one dose of HIB containing vaccine is needed after the first birthday. Sixth grade students must show proof of one dose of the meningococcal conjugate vaccine and one dose of the TDAP vaccine. All new students registering for school must show proof of a physical examination and proper immunizations. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in exclusion from school until requirements are met.
