The meeting was called to order by Secretary Kell at 5:30 pm, and he read a statement as to the time and place of the meeting, as set forth in the "Open Public Meeting Act", (copy attached). He then conducted the Pledge of Allegiance.

- *1. Acknowledge the results of the school board election. The voters of Millville voted as follows: Michael Beatty, Joseph Pepitone and Lisa Santiago were elected as board members for three (3) year terms.
- *2. Affirm that the required oaths for school board members have been signed, and the elected board members have been properly sworn into office.

Mr. Whilden made a motion that the Board accept the election results and the affirmation of required oaths. The motion was seconded by Mr. Flickinger and carried by a unanimous voice vote by all board members.

*3. Secretary Kell opened the nominations for President.

Mr. Pepitone made a motion that Bill Herman be nominated as President, and Mr. Flickinger seconded the motion.

There were no other nominations.

Mr. Donato made a motion that the nominations for president be closed. The motion was seconded by Mr. Flickinger, and a unanimous voice vote by all board members was taken to elect Mr. Herman as president.

*4. President Herman opened the nominations for Vice President.

Mr. Whilden made a motion that Charles Flickinger be nominated as Vice President, and Mr. Donato seconded the motion.

There were no other nominations.

Mr. Whilden made a motion that the nominations for vice-president be closed. The motion was seconded by Mr. Pepitone, and a unanimous voice vote by all board members was taken to elect Mr. Flickinger as Vice President.
